Cooking courses at Château Lavergne

In her magnificent Second Empire Castle, just a few kilometres away from Bordeaux, Suzanne Bourdais receives individuals and groups up to 12 people. Cooking courses are held in French or in English in a friendly and instructive atmosphere.

Bordeaux Saveurs: How did you begin to run cooking courses?

Suzanne Bourdais: Managing director of a vineyard for several years, my personal story started with wine. But when I was speaking about wine, fine cuisine was never far away... And my guests asked me to assist them how to match wine and food. This is how I started my cooking workshops in July 2006.

BS: What are the different options?

SB: Courses take place in a professional kitchen situated in the château's Orangerie. I have several options to offer to my guests? From the simple hands-on cookery class (we prepare a whole menu) that can be associated to a local market's visit or a foie gras workshop. All classes are followed by a lunch or a dinner with a wine tasting.
